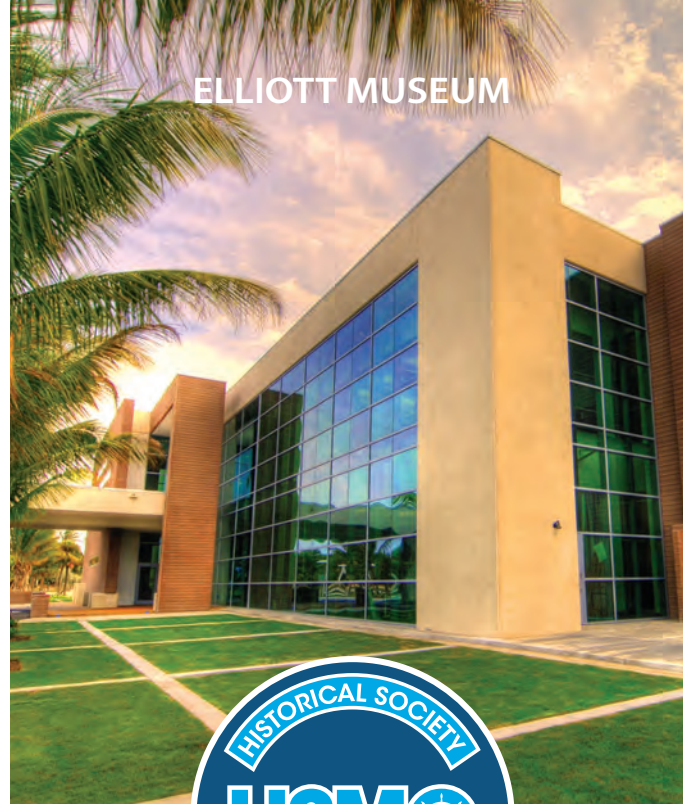

EXPLORE

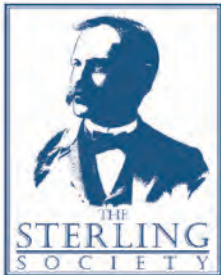

Explore the glory of baseball with more than 600 signed baseball cards, nearly 200 signed baseballs and 11 game-used bats making our collection the 2nd largest exhibit of signed baseball memorabilia outside Cooperstown.

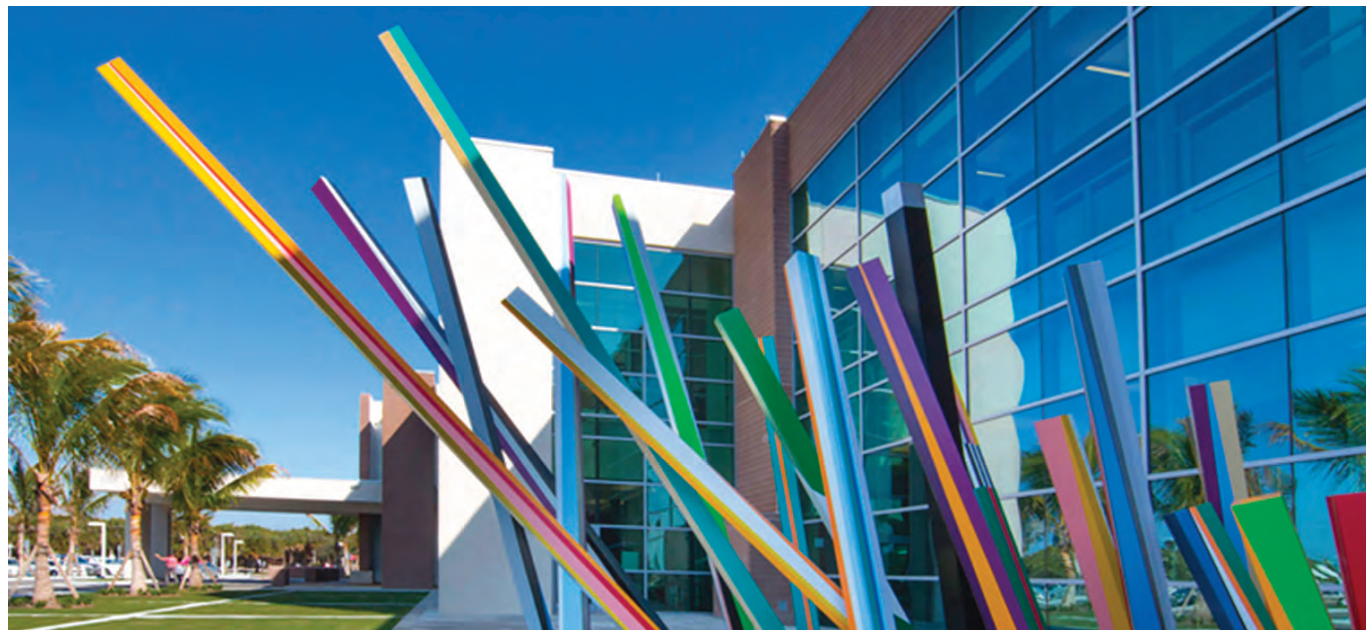
